1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 Purpose

It is the purpose to hire vehicles generically known as Mine-Spec vehicles that comply with specifications tailored to Karara mine’s safety and optional equipment requirements. Specifications cover all aspects of the vehicle’s safety, function and performance while on mining property.

1.2 Background

The Karara Mine operations involve an integrated development of the world-class magnetite deposit at Karara to produce high grade magnetite concentrate for export to China.

1.3 Location

The Karara mine site is located 320 Kilometers, north-north-east of Perth and 225 km east of Geraldton (Figure 1). Construction and Commissioning of Stage 1 of the project (Base Plant), designed to produce 8Mtpa of Magnetite is complete.

2. SCOPE OF WORK

2.1 General

Mine specification vehicle hire covers all aspects of the vehicle’s safety, function and performance while on mining property. Mine-spec vehicles are designed with specific needs tailored to mining safety needs.

Indicative mine equipped light vehicles include, but are not limited to:

1		Dual Cab 4WD or Equivalent
2		Landcruiser 70 Series Dual Cab 4WD or Equivalent
3		Large 4WD Wagon or Equivalent
4		Single Cab Utility or Equivalent
5		12-Seater Minibus or Equivalent

6		22-Seater Coaster or Equivalent
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The scope of the contract includes hiring of light vehicles in a short term and long-term arrangement based on Site’s requirement from time to time for use in Karara mining. The light vehicles to be provided for hiring shall not be older than three (3) years, i.e., the date of original registration of vehicle not before Jan 2022 and the odometer should be less than 60,000 kms.

The Contractor (Light Vehicle Owner) shall submit copies of relevant commercial registration certificates, road permits, certificates of insurance and up to date maintenance and service logbooks.

The light vehicles shall also generally fit with the following standard mine spec features, but not limited to:

- a) Battery isolator switch – A battery isolator switch is fitted to the vehicle to ensure the equipment is safe to work on and the starter is de-energized.
- b) Canvas seat covers - Equipped to ensure damage to seats is minimized in the working environment.
- c) Fire Extinguisher – All vehicles are fitted with standard 1Kg ABE Dry Powder.
- d) Hi-Vis Stripping and signage - Fitted to vehicles in case of low light conditions or night work.
- e) UHF/VHF Radio – For communication on site and more specific sites and jobs.
- f) Minebar - Fitted with: Stop, Tail, Indicator & Reverse Lights, Flashing LED Beacon, Reverse Alarm & Sand Flag, Wheel Chocks.
- g) Bullbar - Equipped for safety on highways and to limit damage to the vehicle in case of a light collision.
- h) First Aid Kit - Equipped to all vehicles in case of minor injury on site.
- i) Tow Bar - All vehicles are fitted with tow bars but only some vehicles are fitted with electronic brakes for greater towing capacity
- j) Spare tyers and tool kits
- k) Air Conditioning
- l) Automatic
- m) Diesel Vehicle
- n) Airbag

2.2 Maintenance Services

The Contractor shall provide the following maintenance services, but not limited to:

- a) Provision of periodic maintenance services;
- b) Ad hoc maintenance services for any damaged vehicle parts or any other issues that were not caused by the Company’s negligence;
- c) Vehicle replacement if necessary due to breakdown, long repairs or accident;
- d) If required, immediate replacement of vehicle must be provided for item (a), (b) and (c).
- e) Fuel full tank at pickup by lessor and on return by lessee.

The Maintenance and Repair Responsibility Matrix below must be read in conjunction with the items above.
