

ITT -2025-976 - Long Term Hire of Vacuum Truck including Operator

Schedule 1 - Scope of work

1 General Requirements

1.1 The Vendor shall supply a fully operational vacuum truck (“Vac Truck”) on a wet-hire basis, inclusive of a suitably qualified operator and trade assistant, hoses, fittings, and all standard consumables necessary for the performance of the Works and exclusive of Fuel

1.2 The Vac Truck shall have a minimum tank capacity of 7,000 litres, unless otherwise approved in writing by Karara Mining Mining.

1.3 The Vendor shall ensure that all personnel assigned to the Works are appropriately qualified, trained, holding all necessary licences/permit/certificates, safety training and competent to perform their duties in a mining environment.

2 Performance of the Works

2.1 Standard of Performance

The Vendor shall perform the Works with the degree of skill, care, diligence, and efficiency expected of a competent Vendor in the mining industry. All activities shall comply with Good Industry Practice, the Site Safety Management Plan, and applicable mining legislation, regulations, and standards.

2.2 Scope of Work Execution

The Vendor shall supply the vacuum truck, operator, and a trade assistant necessary to carry out the Works, on an as required basis, including but not limited to:

Removal, suction, and transfer of liquids, slurries, mud, sediments, and other materials as directed by Karara Mining.

Clearing of sumps, drains, trenches, pits, process plant areas, and mining infrastructure.

Support to shutdown, maintenance, and emergency response activities.

Conducting operations to minimise disruption to ongoing mining operations and ensure safe access around mobile and fixed plant.

2.3 Compliance with Site Requirements

All personnel must comply at all times with Karara Mining's site rules, inductions, traffic management plans, hazard reporting procedures, and lawful directions of the Karara Mining Representative.

2.4 Equipment Condition and Readiness

The Vendor shall ensure the Vac Truck is fully maintained, compliant with statutory requirements, and fit for operation. Safety systems, including emergency stop devices, spill containment, and isolation points, must be fully operational.

2.5 Environmental and Safety Obligations

The Vendor shall perform the Works in compliance with environmental protection, waste management protocols, and contamination control requirements. Safe handling, containment, and disposal of waste is mandatory.

2.6 Performance Monitoring

Karara Mining may monitor, inspect, and assess the Vendor's performance. Non-conformance, safety breaches, or equipment failures must be addressed promptly. Continued failure may result in suspension of the Works or other contractual remedies.

3 Mobilisation and Demobilisation

3.1 The Vendor shall mobilise the Vac Truck, operator, and associated personnel to the site at the agreed date and location.

3.2 Demobilisation shall occur upon completion of the Works or as directed by Karara Mining.

4 Records and Reporting

4.1 The operator shall maintain daily logs recording hours worked, standby hours, tasks completed, and any incidents or issues.

4.2 Daily docketts must be submitted to the Karara Mining Representative for verification and approval.
