

Pre-Tender Notice

HPGR Rotable Screens Rebuild Stands

Karara Mining Limited (hereinafter referred to as the “Company”) intends to conduct a future tender process for the **HPGR Rotable Screens Rebuild Stands** project and hereby invites suitably qualified and experienced suppliers (hereinafter referred to as the “Supplier”) to register their interest in advance.

1. Project Background

During the rebuild process of the HPGR rotatable screens, Company required to place the removed HPGR rotatable screens in the designated rebuild area. After the old screen panels are removed, the mechanical components of the screens are inspected to determine the required scope of rebuild works.

At present, the rotatable screens are placed on relatively low supports during the rebuild process. As a result, there is limited clearance between the bottom of the screen and the ground, making it difficult to properly inspect certain bottom structures and stringer beam areas.

To improve inspection access and reduce future operational risks, Karara Mining Limited intends to procure two new sets of mechanical stands for the HPGR rotatable screens rebuild works.

2. Summary of Scope

The project is expected to include the design, certification, fabrication, supply and documentation of two sets of mechanical stands for HPGR rotatable screens rebuild works. The preliminary scope includes, but is not limited to, the following:

- Complete the design and certification of the mechanical stands in accordance with applicable standards;
- Provide design calculation reports, certification documents, 3D models and fabrication drawings;
- The mechanical stands shall have a minimum load-bearing capacity of not less than **58 tonnes**;
- The stands shall be designed to elevate the bottom of the HPGR vibrating screen to approximately **1000 mm** above ground level, while ensuring that the screen remains level;
- Supply two complete sets of mechanical stands, including all necessary fasteners;
- Provide transport frames, bases or skids as required for delivery of the mechanical stands to the Karara mine site;
- The stands shall be coated with yellow safety warning paint;
- Each set of stands shall be fitted with load rating nameplates;
- Welding shall comply with **AS 1554.1 SP**;
- Welds shall be subject to 100% magnetic particle testing;
- Submit complete MDR documentation, including but not limited to material records, welding records, inspection records, test records, certification documents and as-built documentation.

3. Supplier Requirements

Interested suppliers should have the following capabilities and experience:

- I. Experience in the design, fabrication and supply of mechanical support structures for mining, heavy industry or similar applications;
- II. Capability to perform structural design, welding, inspection and certification in accordance with relevant Australian standards;
- III. Ability to provide appropriate engineering design documents, calculation reports, drawings, inspection records and MDR documentation;
- IV. Appropriate quality management, welding management and safety management capabilities;
- V. Ability to complete supply in accordance with Company’s site delivery and documentation requirements;
- VI. Ability to participate Company’s subsequent tender process, technical clarification process, contract review and commercial review.

4. Information Required for Registration of Interest

Suppliers interested in participating in the subsequent tender process for this project are requested to contact Karara Mining Limited by email to register their interest.

The email should briefly include the following basic information:

1. Supplier's company name (Business name);
2. Contact person's name, position, telephone number and email address;
3. A brief statement confirming whether the company has relevant experience in the design, fabrication and supply of mechanical stands, steel structures, mining equipment support structures or similar works.

Upon receipt of the registration of interest, Company may, subject to project and procurement requirements, provide suitable suppliers with a supplier information form, technical information requirements or formal tender documents.

5. Important Notice

This notice is issued solely as a pre-tender notice or registration of interest notice and does not constitute a formal invitation to tender, request for quotation or contractual commitment. Company reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to determine whether to invite any supplier to participate in the subsequent formal tender process, amend the project scope, cancel the project or modify the procurement process.
